Chairman Smith

 1st few meetings are meant to be informational and get all members on the same page on insurance nuances

Commissioner Raiph Hudgens- SB 236

- Due to requirements & mandates of ACA, insurance premiums are expected to increase dramatically
- Rate shock for 21 yr old male with a HDHP could experience a 141% increase in their premium
- Insurance can't control rates for new policies
 - File & Use state
- Rate increase notice must include % of premium change that is attributable to ACA
- Wall Street Journal Article- underestimates the rate shock that will occur in Georgia

Representative Ben Watson, MD

- Asks for confirmation that the ratio of how much the elderly pay relative to young will go from approx, 7:1 to 3:1
 - o This reflects an increase for the young, not a decrease for the elderly
- Cost redistribution (50-65)
 - Cost for elderly will also go up because of other provisions in the ACA

Commissioner Hudgens

 Because there is a low penalty for opting out, younger people may forgo insurance to save money

Commissioner David Cook

 State employees and teachers have experienced a 16% increase in their insurance premiums over the last couple of years due in part to some of the mandates of ACA that are already in effect. Next year in SHBP, DCH estimates an additional \$60-80 per person cost for premium tax costs

Discussion on Essential Health Benefit Plan (EHB)

- 2 categories our plan doesn't cover
 - o Children's dental & vision
 - Habilitative services (could autism treatment services be covered under this category)

Senator Renee Unterman

- Whose numbers do we use?
 - o Will the private sector contribute?
- There was a commitment from OPB (Trip Addison) to provide official numbers
 - There will be input from the private sector and the Insurance Commissioner
